Key to the concept was to adhere to the conventions of the movie 'trailer' but also give the film a sense of narrative closure (similar to a short film), so experience goers can take home a fully-contained, social-media shareable film.

The Creative Director for Carnage on the project Oisin Tymon said 'from the moment James Keane (Digital Creative, Imagination) spoke to us about *Go Faster*, we fell in love with the concept; a track day meets Secret Cinema. *Go Faster* was a unique creative challenge, and the perfect project to launch the Carnage Branded Entertainment division. We've bought our tickets and can't wait to have a go!'.
