

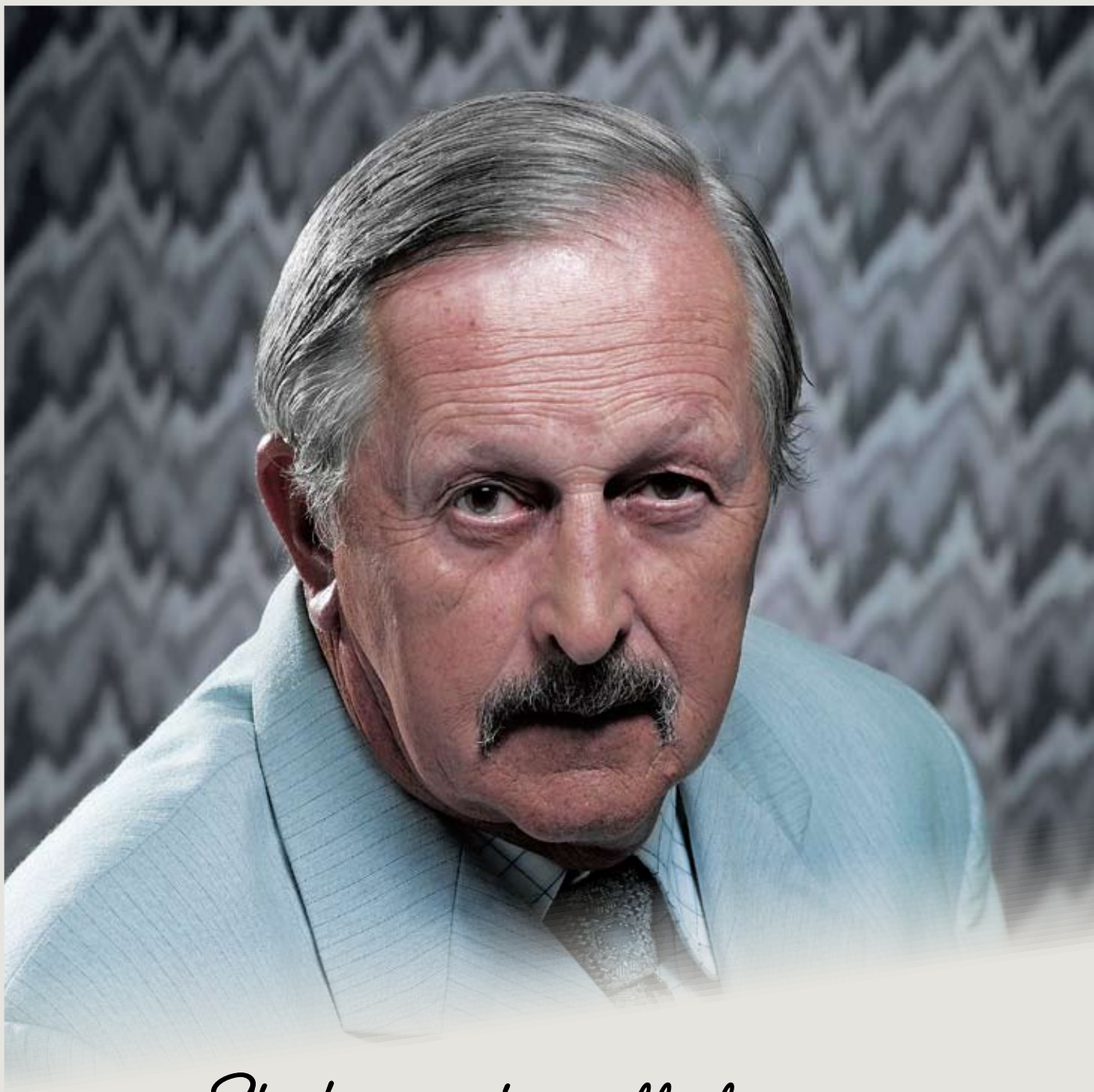


Putting the king back into stalking.
